What is Dual Enrollment?

- Enroll in a college class while you are still in high school
- Classes available in Fall/Spring/Summer terms
- Earn **High School Credits AND College Units!**
- Complete High School Graduation and/or A-G Requirements
- Enroll in electives or other classes of interest
- College grades ARE posted on your high school transcript
- Tuition is **FREE** while you are in High School! (You pay Supplies, Books, and **\$33** for Enrollment Fees) ***Pay these fees, so you are not dropped from your class***

3 College Units = 10 High School Credits



Credit By Exam: Why should I take the test?

- Earn **High School Credits AND College Units!**
- Complete High School Graduation and/or A-G Requirements for Universities
- You may be able to graduate early or avoid staying an extra semester in college
- It is **FREE** (Petaluma City Schools will pay the fees!)

3 College Units = 10 High School Credits



Dual Enrollment: Steps:

- Meet with your School Counselor. Ask questions.
- Set up **Open CCC** Account (After April 1st)
- Complete **SRJC Application** (Make sure to specify: **Summer 2026 or Fall 2026**)
- Look for Welcome email from SRJC: Set up SRJC ***Bear Cub*** Account
- Submit **Dual Enrollment Form**: (Make sure to specify: **Summer or Fall 2026**)

The Dual Enrollment Form must list the exact course name (For Example: ASL 1)

- Enroll in the the class on **Priority Date**
- You will need to know the **SECTION NUMBER of the course** for Enrollment.
- *For Work Experience classes only:* Email the Instructor and request an **ADD CODE Be sure to Specify the SECTION Number in the email!**
