Birth Certificate




You can order a birth certificate online, by phone, by mail, or in person


- Information needed:

 - Your parents place of birth

Social Security Card/ DACA Social Security Card





Order a Replacement SS/DACA Card



- If you are under 18: visit the office in person (make an appointment!)
- If you are over 18: request a card online

You must have a birth certificate and proof of identity such as a passport or school ID card.

California ID Card





If you are ordering a CA ID for the first time, you must visit the DMV and provide the following:

 <u>DMV application 44</u>, thumb print, SS card/DACA card, proof of residency, photo, birth certificate, pay \$35 fee

If you don't have a CA ID, you can use a passport

Work Permit



What is it?

An agreement between you, your parents/guardians, your employer, and your school



Why do I need it?

Protection from unsafe work environments



What's required?

Be 14-17 years old, excellent attendance, and have a 2.0 GPA



When do I get it?

AFTER you receive a job offer

Get work permit before job offer




Get job offer before work permit

- 1. Get a job offer
- 2. Pick up a work permit application
 - a. In the counseling office
 - b. In the College & Career Center
 - c. On the <u>College & Career Center</u> <u>Website</u>
- 3. You, parent/guardian, and employer sign the application
- 4. Return the application to Mr. Silver or to the Counseling Secretaries

During the summer, contact the <u>Petaluma City Schools District Office</u>

CDE B1-1 (Rev. 07-10)

General Summary of Minors' Work Regulations

FLSA-Federal Labor Standards Act, CDE-California Department of Education, EC-California Education Code, LC-California Labor Code, CFR-California Federal Regulations

- If federal laws, state laws, and school district policies conflict, the more restrictive law (the one most protective of the minor) prevails. (FLSA)
- Employers of minors required to attend school must complete a "Statement of Intent to Employ a Minor and Request for Work Permit" (CDE B1-1) for the school attendance for each such minor. (EC 49162)
- Employers must retain a "Permit to Employ and Work" (CDE B1-4) for each such minor. (EC 49161)
- Work permits (CDE B1-4) must be retained for three years and be available for inspection by sanctioned authorities at all times. (EC 49164)
- A work permit (CDE B1-4) must be revoked whenever the issuing authority determines the employment is illegal or is impairing the health or education of the minor. (EC 49164)

 A day of rest from work is required in every seven days, and shall not exceed six days in seven. (LC 551, 552)

Minors under the age of 18 may not work in environments declared hazardous or dangerous for young workers, examples listed below: (LC 1294.1 and 1294.5, 29 CFR 570 Subpart E)

- Explosive exposure
- Motor vehicle driving/outside helper
- 3. Roofing
- Logging and sawmilling
- Power-driven woodworking machines
- Radiation exposure
- Power-driven hoists/forklifts
- Power-driven metal forming, punching, and shearing machines
- 9. Power saws and shears
- 10. Power-driving meat slicing/processing machines

Living Wage vs. Minimum Wage





- Minimum wage varies by State and differs from Federal minimum wage
- Living wages are passed by cities/counties and supersede State minimum wage
- Petaluma has a minimum wage!

Tips for Resumes

- First job?
 - Paid work experience (babysitting, moving, yardwork, etc.)
 - Volunteer work, leadership roles, clubs, sports teams etc.
- Education/relevant coursework/GPA
- Do not list your address
- Clean format and font (10-12pt)
- Avoid fancy fonts
- Use spell check and proofread
- One page max
- Bilingual? List it!

- 1. Partner up

 - What are your strengths?
 - What are your weaknesses?
 - Why should I hire you?
