Transfers

- Determine your District of residence by visiting: petalumacityschools.org/enroll/transfer-information
- If your district of residence is Petaluma City Schools, or it is a charter school (Penngrove, Waldorf, Cherry Valley) you **DO NOT** need an inter-district transfer. Just complete the online enrollment application.
- If your district of residence is not Petaluma City Schools, complete the inter-district transfer form & submit it to transfers@petk12.org
- Be sure to complete the standard online enrollment application as well. Once your transfer is approved, your application will be processed.

Enrolment Process

- Tour schools and learn about all options and programs
- Cather all required documentation
 - a. Date of Birth Confirmation
 - b. Proof of address, such as: utility bill or rental agreement
 - c. Immunization Records must be submitted in order to attend school)
 - d. If applicable: Inter-district or Intradistrict Transfer Form
- Apply during the open enrollment window (January 8 February 13)
 - Wait to receive an offer (Plan to hear in March!)
 - 5 Accept your offer

HELP THEM GET R.E.A.D.Y!

R-ROUTINES & RESTROOM SKILLS

- Practice simple routines and 1–2 step directions.
- Build independence using the restroom (wiping, flushing, handwashing).
- Try dressing skills: zipping, buttoning, putting on sweaters or jackets.

E-EXPRESS YOURSELF

- Encourage your child to say what they need or want.
- Practice speaking in complete sentences.
- Use an appropriate voice volume and learn how to get someone's attention politely.

A-ALLABOUT SHARING

- Take turns, share toys, and practice waiting patiently.
- Learn how to sit for short periods and focus on a simple task.

D-DO-IT-MYSELF SKILLS

- Managing their own backpack: lunchbox, water bottle, books, folder, sweater/jacket.
- Cleaning up after themselves at home to build the habit for school.

Y-YES TO NEW EXPERIENCES!

- Talk about school in positive, exciting ways.
- Prepare for the big goodbye:
- Create a simple, comforting goodbye plan (e.g., "Hug, kiss, high-five—then you go have a great day!").
- Practice short separations so your child feels confident and safe with new caregivers.
