("PETALUMA CITY SCHOOLS"), HONORING THE CONTRIBUTION OF THE
TEACHERS TO QUALITY EDUCATION AND DECLARING THE WEEK OF
MAY 4-8, 2026 AS THE WEEK OF THE TEACHER**
